## Matters Arising:

- a) Shell Station planning application: This application has now been revises following concerns over pedestrian access and vehicle ingress and egress points plus movement around the site. Matters not addressed are development within the conservation area, inappropriate illumination of signs, plus pedestrian access issues are still not fully resolved. At the time of writing these notes the plans committee has asked for consultation to take place between the applicant and the local authority members as representatives of the community. The planning decision is therefore in abeyance.
- b) Weidman Whiteley pre planning application enquiry for 9 houses to be built on the sports ground on their site: The applicant has stated their aim is to raise funds from this development in order to safeguard the jobs of local people who work in their premises in Pool. The steering group is not convinced by this argument.
- c) 35 houses off Chapel Hill Road: serious flooding issues surround this site. It lies immediately off the narrow and dangerous road Old Pool Bank where traffic and pedestrian safety is already of great concern.
- d) It was noted that the result of the recent planning appeal involving Grove Lane/Boston Spa means that central government now requires all sites previously identified to be put back in to consideration for development in order to achieve the increased housing requirement. This is means it is imperative to have a plan in place to best influence Pool-in-Wharfedale's development for the future.
