

## **Village Design Statement corrections.**

(No mention of the settlement of Caley as part of the Parish of Pool)

### **Location**

Almescliffe Crag (corrected spelling)

There are **three** settlements (PiW, OPB and Caley)

"mills powered by the River Wharfe" in fact Old Corn Mill, Mill Lane powered by water from the land not the River Wharfe.

**Economy:** Whiteley family moved into the paper mill in 1886.

Purchased by them in 1918

Weidmann (corrected spelling)

**Settlement:** Bridge date 1754

### **Building and Evolution construction:**

Manor of Pool lasted from 1293 to 1902

Caley Hall (the original Tudor building) was demolished in 1964.

now replaced by a house of same name built c.1975

### **Victorian Houses etc.**

Pool Road is incorrect should read Otley Road. (confirmed as Otley Road by PPC in 2002)

### **Building & Evolution etc.**

Wharfe Crescent was built before WW2 in 1929/30
